In re: Cox Enterprises, Inc. Set-Top Cable Television Box Antitrust Litigation (W.D. Okla.)

Plaintiffs alleged Cox Enterprises violated Sherman Act, 15 U.S.C. § 1 through illegal tying by forcing consumers to rent a Cox set-top box in order to gain full access to Cox's premium cable service. After a jury verdict in favor of the plaintiffs, the District Court entered judgment as a matter of law in favor of the defendant.
